NICK LEITCH HAS THE “Y FACTOR”

Endless' Director Nick Leitch takes the trophy home as Birmingham's 2010 Y Factor Winner

The X Factor-style event was held at The Glee Club in Birmingham on 24 March and saw Dealmakers from the Midlands' corporate finance community transformed into budding singers for one night, raising more than £35,000 for charity Mencap.

Nick won over the 450-strong crowd with his rendition of the Frankie Valli classic, Can't Take My Eyes Off You.
